## Farewell to “Jumbo”

Since 1970, passengers, crew, and pilots alike have been enjoying flying on the Boeing 747. It can carry about 500 passengers and fly as far as 6,000 miles leading to the age of modern jet travel at the time. However, the one-time “Queen of the Skies” has been slowly becoming obsolete. Jumbo's double deck and four engines devour a vast amount of fuel which cuts into airline profitability. Hence the phasing out of the plane is underway among carriers in the US and around the world. Fortunately, if you want to fly with the queen before she’s gone for good, there are still a handful of airlines operating the plane.
